It is understood that at the time of sale, this dog is not considered to be of show or breeding quality, but is representative of its breed and is structurally and temperamentally suited as a companion and / or obedience dog. This animal must be spayed or neutered on or before 8 months of age. The Registration Certificate for this animal will be forwarded to the buyer upon receipt of a copy of the spay / neuter certificate, or verification by a Veterinarian that the animal has been spayed / neutered.

GUARANTEE

The breeder guarantees this animal to be in good health and free from any parasites, virus, and bacterial diseases for a period of forty eight (48) hours from the date of sale. A full refund will be given for any puppy found unsatisfactory or ill within the first forty eight (48) hours. Illness must be verified by a veterinarian at the buyer's expense. **This puppy is also guaranteed for 3 years against any hereditary or congenital defect**, which develops to the extent that it renders the animal unsuitable as a pet. Verification by a veterinarian at the buyer's expense is required. In this instance, the animal will be returned to the breeder and a replacement will be given when one becomes available. The breeder has a right to obtain a second opinion, at the breeder's expense.

PURCHASER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The purchaser agrees to love and care for this animal; to keep this animal safe, maintain a schedule of inoculations and worming; maintain his/her health and well-being and provide adequate food and shelter.

The purchaser agrees **NOT** to dispose of this animal to any third party, nor to have the animal destroyed without the breeder's knowledge. Should it become necessary for the purchaser to dispose of the dog, he/she will be returned to the breeder and the breeder will be responsible for placing the dog in a new home. The purchaser will sign Transfer of ownership papers if the dog is returned for a replacement or resell. The breeder cannot guarantee to resell the animal for the full purchase price, however, monies from the sale of the dog will be forwarded to the first buyer after expenses have been paid. Expenses may include advertisement fees, inoculations, and health check by a Veterinarian or any cost incurred in ensuring that the animal is healthy.

Failure to uphold the terms of this contract will result in the animal being repossessed by the breeder and the buyer must sign the transfer of ownership and surrender the animal's registration papers.
